

Caring for your Furniture

Outdoor furniture is protected by a special surface treatment which provides longevity of use, if treated and cared for properly.

If imperfections should be discovered in the coating, these can be easily repaired with the care set that is available from us. First, rub down the areas concerned with a rough sandpaper, then carefully smooth off with a fine sandpaper, wipe over with a clean cloth and touch up with the paint applicator.

Care of your furniture is very straightforward. You only need to clean your furniture once or twice a year using a cloth and warm soapy water. We also recommend that the furniture be polished once a year with a polish or wax such as that used on cars, to ensure optimum resistance to weathering.

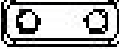


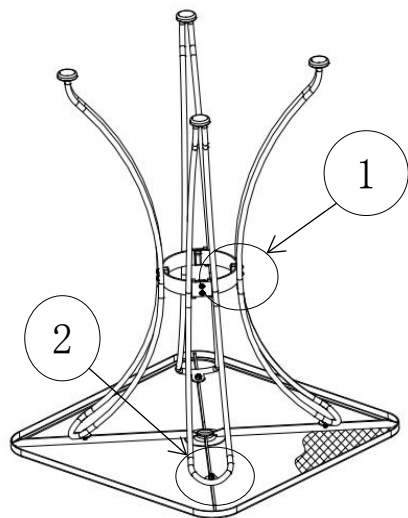
Step by Step Assembly Instructions

Pre-Assembly Preparation

1. Please check the contents in the box before attempting to assemble this product. A full checklist of components is given in this Assembly Instruction manual. If any components are missing, please contact the dealer from whom you bought this product.
2. This product is Heavy. It should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use. Handle Product With Care to avoid personal injury and (or) damage to the product.

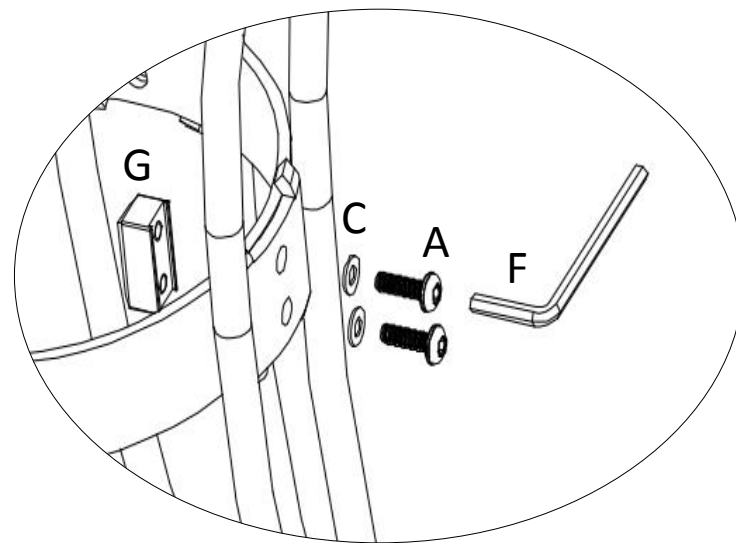
Ensure the table top is on a protected surface during assembly to avoid damage to the table surface.



Assemble all parts loosely and when all components are in place tighten to secure.

Attach the Leg Connecting Frame to each Table Leg using the Washer (C), Screws (A) and Square Nut (G). Loosely tighten in a clockwise direction using the Allen Key (F). Repeat for each Leg.

Attach the assembled Table Legs to the Table Top using Washer (C), Nut (B) and Cap (D). Loosely tighten in a clockwise direction using the Open Wrench (E).
